



With her distinctive voice and evocative sound, award winning artist SEAY (pronounced 'say'), has gained prominence as a vocalist, composer, and humanitarian. Her artistry has touched the heart and universal chord in people drawing listeners from across the globe, with her music airing on radio, satellite and syndicated programs. Seay is a Billboard award winning artist, Grammy® nominated featured artist, Global Ambassador with Project Peace on Earth and a 3 time recipient of the Peace Song Awards. RJ Lannan Curator of Artisan Reviews, said *"If you had but one voice it should be Seay, she will leave an impression on your spirit, and it will be a blessing."*

With classical training in both voice and music, Seay's formative years were spent playing piano, studying voice and living internationally with her family throughout the Far East, while her father an army physician finished his medical residency. Growing up in a creative household, Seay was exposed to the arts, the world's cultures and languages. She later attended the Sotheby's Institute of Art in London completing an MA Degree in Decorative Arts, while studying voice with England's Helena Shenel. It was while living in England and returning to her family's roots, her music journey began singing on projects for song publishers Carlin, Motown, Warner Chappell Music, artists Elaine Paige and Annie Lennox and performing in London's music scene. Seay later attended the University of Southern California with graduate studies Opera and included studies with longtime voice coach, luminary Seth Riggs. .

In recent years, Seay has forged an atmospheric cinematic style of music as a vocalist and songwriter in her Illumination Music Studio with her company Tuscan Sun Music, based outside of Nashville, in Franklin, Tennessee. She has released 5 albums in Global, New Age, Adult Contemporary genres. Her critically acclaimed "In The Garden, charted on the Billboard New Age albums chart for 5 weeks peaking at #3 and won the coveted ZMR vocal album of the year. Her debut album '1 Voice' an album of global influences and celestial vocals was featured on the launch of XM's HD Surround in 5.1DTS alongside Sting, Ray Charles, Enya and Norah Jones. Her first of 2 seasonal albums 'A Winter Blessing' with several guest instrumentalists, was named on Mainly Piano's Top 30 albums of the last decade. Her inspirational single and video 'All Around The World' was featured in the opening ceremonies of World Peace Day and the theme for Project Peace on Earth's "Love All' Simulcast from Bethlehem, on Christmas Day, "All Around The World" and has been heard on 1000 radio stations and seen by over 80 million people across the globe with a mission of celebrating those common ties that join us as human beings : Love, compassion, and worship. Seay's art and activism has included her vocal chant piece "Orion's Gate" on Project Peace on Earth's "2 Unite All" Volumes 1 and 2 with 26 world artists including Peter Gabriel, Roger Waters, Stewart Copeland, in support of The United Nations. Seay's music is also a regular addition to the syndicated channels Sirius Spa, Music Choice Soundscapes and the Care Channel airing in hospitals, health and wellness centers.

Seay has been blessed to work and perform with many artists in recordings and humanitarian events including Annie Lennox, Cher, Elaine Paige, Clay Walker, Crystal Gayle, Patti Austin, Ricky Kej, David Arkenstone, Paul Avgerinos, and Peter Sterling. Her recent vocal work includes, The Grammy® nominated "Pangaea" with David Arkenstone and Wouter Kellerman, and "Shanti Samsara" launching the United Nations COP Climate Change conference/Paris accord with French President Francois Mitterrand, Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi and produced by Grammy® winning Composer Ricky Kej. Seay was featured on the title track "Shanti" with voiceover by Rosanna Arquette, Francis Fisher, Lindsay Wagner and Amitabh Bachchan, "Kudrat" for the Elephants, and "Love Divine" with Patti Austin to promote and raise awareness for Environmental consciousness and sustainability. Seay also made a guest appearance on "Gandhi, Mantras of Compassion" on "Be The Change", celebrating the life of Mahatma Gandhi, with Ricky Kej, Tina Guo, Masa Takumi and Nobel Peace Laureate Kailash Satyarthi. One of the special honors of her musical career has been performing a benefit concert of the songs of Oscar Winning Lyricists Alan And Marilyn Bergman, with the Bergmans performing.

Seay is also visual artist. Her artwork can be found in private collections and her exhibit "The Power of Sound" has been seen on ABC Lifetime channel, The Nashville Jazz Workshop, The Songwriters Guild and Universal Music.

Seay is a voting member of the Recording Academy, a SESAC affiliated writer, Music Ambassador for Project Peace On Earth and an Artist for the Earth on the Earthday Network.
